P.G. Farmers Market board decides not to move.

The Pacific Grove farmer's market may not be [changing its place and time](#) after all.

The board of Everyone's Harvest, the organization that runs the market, decided March 14 not to apply for a use permit modification that would set the stage for a [market change from its current digs](#), Monday evenings on downtown Lighthouse Avenue, to Saturday mornings in a city-owned parking lot south of Lighthouse.

The decision came after the board heard from 20 speakers and received more 20 letters on the issue.

"We understand there is not unanimous agreement in the P.G. community regarding the best location for the P.G. Market, and we value everyone's feelings and thoughts expressed regarding this issue," reads a March 17 letter from EH Board President Kathryn Spencer. "Our goal in running the Market is not to divide the community, but to bring people together."
