Everyone's Harvest does so only as a public service to the people attending the markets and by doing so it does not endorse or oppose any candidate or measure.

**TO APPLY TO RESERVE A FREE PARTICIPANTE BOOTH SPACE AT THE FARMERS' MARKET(S) YOUR GROUP MUST UNDERSTAND: A CHARITABLE PARTY** may apply to receive approval from the Market Manager to have a free booth space at the Market(s) for purposes of outreaching the Charitable Party's services and/or activities to the local community and for fundraising activities. All Parties are considered on a weekly and rotating basis in order to give all interested Parties a fair chance at attending the Market(s). Upon request from Everyone's Harvest, the charitable group must provide proof: the Group is currently active and the Representative position in the Group is valid with publications or minutes from a Group's meeting. The Group must provide their own, table(s), chair(s) and Group's publications. Walking outside of the Participant's designated space and passing out publications is prohibited. No items sold for fundraising activities by the Groups may compete with paying Participants. Everyone's Harvest reserves the right to determine if a fundraising activity is competing with a paying Participant.

**ALL GROUPS MUST:**

- Be a group of people working to help the common good
- Have educational information about your group's mission and vision displayed at your booth.
- Money generated from fundraising activities at the market must go back into the group's mission and not compete with paid Market vendors or farmers.
