The purpose of the 2025 Rules and Regulations is to govern, administer, and manage Everyone's Harvest Certified Farmers' Markets. In issuing these rules, it is not our intent to burden participants, but to ensure the smooth operations. Please initial and sign below agreeing you and your employees understand the 2025 Rules & Regulations. Note some key points below:

EXPECTED BEHAVIOR 7.1 Anti-Harassment Policy: Harassment will not be tolerated by Participants, Employees, Contractors or any member of the Board at EH CFM(s), public events or meetings. This includes but is not limited to, use of abusive, profane or demeaning language and sexual harassment.

7.2 Ethics Code: EH Board believes that a code of ethics is basic to the conduct of EH CFM(s). All Participants, Employees, Contractors and any Member of the Board shall conduct their professional lives in accordance with following statement: "Be civil and respectful in professional interactions, avoiding discrimination, based on race, gender, sexual orientation, religion, or age. Treat everyone fairly and with respect."

_____7.3 Standard of Conduct: All Participants, Employees, Contractors, EH Market Managers and Members of the Board at the Market(s), public functions and meetings must: Be knowledgeable about their products (how they are used, grown or produced) and clearly communicate this to Customers. Be courteous, professional and presentable. Display products in a clean, presentable and attractive way. Be honest and conduct themselves at all times in a courteous and business-like manner. Dress and behave in an appropriate manner, including wearing shirts and shoes. Not use illegal drugs, drink alcoholic beverages, yell, heckle, swear, name call, make slanderous remarks, throw items, fight or participate in other offensive behavior. Treat others, including Participants, Employees, Contractors, Board Members, Customers, and Officials, with respect. Not sell any stolen or pirated items. These are prohibited for sale by any Participant at EH CFM(s)

Any items related to or in support of Non-Profit Corporations, Community Groups and School Clubs for fundraising purposes may be sold or given away without the approval of the EH Market Manager. No items may compete with products offered for sale by a Certified Producer, Fisherman, Seafood Broker, Food Purveyor or Participant. Selling select products is permitted on a limited basis.



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_____PARTICIPANT APPROVAL: Each Participant must reapply and be approved each year for participation in each Everyone's Harvest Certified Farmers' Market. The decision to approve a Participant to participate in an Everyone's Harvest Certified Farmers' Market is made by the Executive Director or the Board of Directors with recommendations from the Market Manager

_____Participants are responsible to furnish Everyone's Harvest with copies of current required documents form the city, state, county and federal government for applicable activities the Participant conducts at the Market(s). It is the responsibility of every Participant at every Market to post their current required documents.

Participants shall arrive at least 30 minutes before the start of the EH CFM(s). No Participant may leave the EH CFM(s) before the EH CFM(s) closes without permission. Leaving early may cause the Participant to be excluded from future EH CFMs. A Participant is not allowed to enter the EH CFM(s) after EH CFM(s) starting time without EH Market Manager approval and supervision. All Participants must notify the EH Market Manager if they are going to be late and will not be able to enter and set-up their stall before the required time. Auto and truck flow must not endanger pedestrians.

_____Participants entering the EH CFM(s) area must drive very carefully and always under 3mph. If a Participant needs to move any cones or barricades to get their vehicle in or out of the EH CFM area, they must be immediately replaced after entering or exiting. If any Participant does not follow the above procedure, they will be fined and/or subject to being excluded from selling at EH CFM(s).

PARTICIPANT LIABILITY WAIVER

THIS PARTICIPANT LIABILITY WAIVER ("Waiver") is entered into effective as of the date of signature in consideration for you ("Releasor" or "Participant") receiving permission to enter, rent, lease, license, occupy or otherwise make use of selling space (the "Market Space") at an EVERYONE'S HARVEST CERTIFIED FARMERS' MARKET (the "Market") operated by Everyone's Harvest, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation ("Everyone's Harvest").

AGREEMENT

1. General Release. In consideration of Everyone's Harvest granting me the right to use the Market Space, I, for myself, my employees, agents, representatives, and assigns, hereby release and hold harmless Everyone's Harvest, and its contractors, directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives and assigns ("Releasees"), from all claims of negligence resulting in personal injury, accident, illness (including death) or property damage arising from or relating to my participation in the Market and use of the Market Space.

2. Assumption of Risk. In executing this release, I acknowledge that participation in the Market and use of the Market Space carries certain inherent dangers that cannot readily be eliminated regardless of the care taken to prevent and avoid injury, and hereby additionally assume the risk of liability for injury, accident, or illness, including death, resulting from such dangers. These dangers include, without limitation, heavy lifting, falling objects, exposure to hazardous materials or equipment, exposed wires, moving vehicles, and uneven footing, as well as general risks including, but not limited to slips, trips, falls, cuts, adverse weather conditions, falling trees or branches, and the acts or omissions of Market customers or vendors or other members of the public. I understand that the description of the risks in this Waiver is not complete and that other risks or events arising from participation in the Market or use of the Market Space, both known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, may result in serious bodily injury, death, or property damage.

3. Indemnification. I agree to indemnify and defend Releasees, through their own choice of counsel, against any and all claims arising out of or related to the negligent or intentional acts or omissions of myself, my employees, agents, representatives or assigns in connection with my participation in the Market or use of the Market Space, including any acts or omissions undertaken in contravention of Everyone's Harvest's Rules and Regulations.

4. Compliance with Laws. I agree to obey all laws, ordinances, rules and regulations adopted or established by Federal, State, or local governmental agencies or bodies while participating in the Market or using the Market Space.

5. Media Release. In further consideration for my use of the Market Space, I authorize Everyone's Harvest the use of my likeness or identifying information in any publications or publicity materials. including but not limited to, books, internet and web content, newsletters, newspapers, and other means of advertising, without any compensation or fee being paid.

6. Choice of Law. I agree that any dispute concerning this Waiver will be governed by the laws of the State of California and that the exclusive venue for any dispute that may arise out of this Agreement will be in Monterey County, California. If any clause or provision of this Waiver is held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such clause or provision will not otherwise affect the remaining provisions of this Agreement, which will continue to be enforceable.
